

Discovery News for Discovery Health members

You can add members to your medical aid plan at any time.

- \Rightarrow Newborns: babies should be added within 30 days of birth to be added free of any underwriting.
- ⇒ Adopted children can be added as soon as you have official paperwork showing guardianship or a final adoption, or you and your social worker can complete Discovery's affidavit regarding the care of the minor if the adoption is not yet official or if you are fostering the child.
- ⇒ Spouses can be added free of underwriting within 3 months of the date of marriage. At any other time, they will be subject to waiting periods. If you are merging two Discovery members into one membership, and you are not both on the same plan, this needs to be done effective 1st January or within 3 months of marriage.
- \Rightarrow Step children (or the children of your partner if not married) can be added as long as your spouse or partner is also on your medical aid.
- ⇒ Addition of adult dependants over age 21: You can add your children over age 21 or your parents, provided that they are financially dependant on you. This means they either live with you or you pay their living expenses, and you support them with their daily living expenses. Financial questionnaires may be called for to prove dependency. If they are not accepted as dependants, you can place them on their own medical aid membership, and pay the debit order from your bank account.

There are day-to-day extender benefits that are available to you on certain plans when you have run out of Savings.

- ⇒ Executive, Classic Comprehensive or Classic Priority: if you use a provider with a payment arrangement with Discovery, you have unlimited gynaecologist consultations and two 2D scans available when in your self payment gap
- ⇒ Classic Saver or Classic Delta Saver: if you use a provider with a payment arrangement with Discovery, you have 8 gynaecologist consultations and two 2D scans available when you have run out of Savings

Birth-related hospital expenses are covered as follows:

- ⇒ KeyCare Plus or KeyCare Core: 3 days and 2 nights in hospital for a normal delivery, and 4 days and 3 nights for an approved caesarean section.
- ⇒ KeyCare Access: 2 days and 1 night in hospital for a normal delivery, and 3 days and 2 nights for an approved caesarean section.
- \Rightarrow All other plans: 3 days and 2 nights in hospital for a normal delivery, and 4 days and 3 nights for an approved caesarean section.
- \Rightarrow Home births are covered from the hospital benefit, and your midwife must be registered with a valid practice number.
- ⇒ Water births are covered at home or in hospital. Hospital cover will include 3 days and 2 nights. At home, the cost of hiring the birthing pool is covered from the hospital benefit from a registered provider with a valid practice number. The birthing pool is limited to R1000 on KeyCare plans.

Vitality: Are you on your way to Gold

It is always recommended that you earn as many points on your Vitality journey as early in the year as possible. Leaving everything to the last minute does not work, especially this year when you can't get to Gold without earning some fitness points.

Here is a breakdown of what every member could have earned thus far.

- \Rightarrow Vitality Age Questionnaire: online questionnaire: 2500 points
- ⇒ Vitality Health Check: at Dis-Chem, Clicks, various other pharmacies and the Discovery Wellness Centres: earn 2500 points for doing the assessment, and points for tests results in normal range (2500 points for 2, 7500 for 3, 12,500 for 4 or 17,500 for 5. Includes BP, Glucose, Cholesterol, BMI and smoking status.
- \Rightarrow HIV test (with the Vitality Health Check): 5000 points
- ⇒ Vitality Fitness Assessment: at participating biokineticist or Discovery Wellness Centres: costs R375: 2500 points for completing the test and up to 5000 additional points depending on your fitness level.
- \Rightarrow Fitness activities: from 100 to 300 points per day for various physical activities
- ⇒ Health checks: All members can earn 1000 for a dental consultation, females earn 2500 for a pap smear and 2500 for a mammogram, adults over 40 earn 2500 for a Glaucoma screening, adults over 50 ear 2500 for a colonoscopy
- \Rightarrow Members over 60 earn 1000 for a vision test, 2000 for flu vaccinations, 1000 for shingles vaccinations and 1000 for a pneumococcal vaccination

Vitality Active Rewards: new partners

From Wednesday 29th March, you will be able to choose rewards from Mugg & Bean and Ster Kinekor.

Vitality Active Rewards members will be able to use rewards at any **Mugg & Bean** sit-down restaurant or On-The-Move store across the country, for a variety of drinks on the menu. For take-aways, the cashier will scan the wiCode at the till when you purchase. For sit-down meals, you will be able to scan the QR code on the till slip to reduce the total cost.

Ster-Kinekor will offer a small or regular popcorn at the snack counters, by putting in the wiCode at the till.

Kauai is changing slightly in that the meal add-ons will not be available from 1st April, according to Kauai stores (not confirmed by Vitality).

DiscoveryCard Cash Back and Miles Multiplier

From 15th April 2017, DiscoveryCard holders will no longer earn cash back when paying with their DiscoveryCard at Incredible Connection, Toys R Us, Babies R Us, Reggies and The Pro Shop.

You have to activate Discovery Miles for the Multiplier Benefit, and you earn 1x Miles on Blue Status, 2x on Bronze, 3x on Silver, 5x on Gold and 10x on Diamond.

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
